
By prioritizing these events, the board is ensuring that members have access to valuable resources and a strong







environmental impact of construction and development.




he review seeks to equip architects with the knowledge and tools to address the growing challenges posed


Ar. Rowel Hilario's session on Building Utilities delved into

He explored key infrastructure components such as plumbing, electrical systems, HVAC (heating, ventilation, and air conditioning), and fire safety. The discussion emphasized the critical role that these utilities play in creating sustainable, comfortable, and safe spaces while also addressing the integration of these systems into the broader architectural design process.

Adrian Bolalin took participants on a journey through History the of Architecture, tracing evolution of architectural styles and the socio-cultural forces shaped that them. His discussion spanned multiple periods, from ancient civilizations to modern times, offering a deep understanding architecture how responded to societal needs, technological advances, and artistic movements. This session served as a reminder of how historical context continues to influence architectural contemporary practice.

Ar. Micaela Pasiona's talk on Space Planning and Interior Design focused on the creation of functional, aesthetically pleasing, and efficient interiors. Ar.
