In celebration of World Architectural Day (WAD), the UAP Qatar Chapter visited the exhibit in M7 at Musherib Downtown Doha Qatar as part of the 2024 4th Edition of the Zwara Exhibition.

Our very own Ar. Stephen Amoyo, a member of the UAP Qatar Chapter and a promising multidisciplinary designer who was also featured as a young aspiring Architect during the UAP Qatar 1<sup>st</sup> GMM and Anniversary Celebration got his spotlight when he received distinctions as a product and furniture designer in Qatar when he designed the "The Waiting Chair". Ar. Amoyo is the first Filipino Architect to be part of Zwara program. A truly amazing Young Architect and a gem of the UAP Qatar Chapter.



Just two and a half years since arriving in Qatar, Arch. Stephen Amoyo, a graduate of the University of Santo Tomas College of Architecture, has already made a name as a promising multidisciplinary designer. He became a registered and licensed architect in 2023, and has received distinctions as a product and furniture designer in Qatar.

His design "The Waiting Chair" is currently on display as part of the 2024 Zwara Exhibit in M7, an innovation and start-up hub established by Qatar Museums. Arch. Stephen is the first ever Filipino to be part of the Zwara program, where he collaborated with fellow designers, curator and architect - Jumannah Abbas, and mentors from Vera Design Museum in Germany, for a 10 month creative journey in product design - exploring the process from concept to completion.

Arch. Stephen has also received an Honorable Mention for Distinctive Design and Functional Originality during the FROMM.Lab Crafting Heritage Workshop in February 2024 for his design "Lulupa Wall Lamp". Inspired by the allure of pearl diving in the Gulf region and in the Philippines, the lamp was a nod to the competitor's goal of fostering cultural exploration through innovative and culturally-rooted product designs.

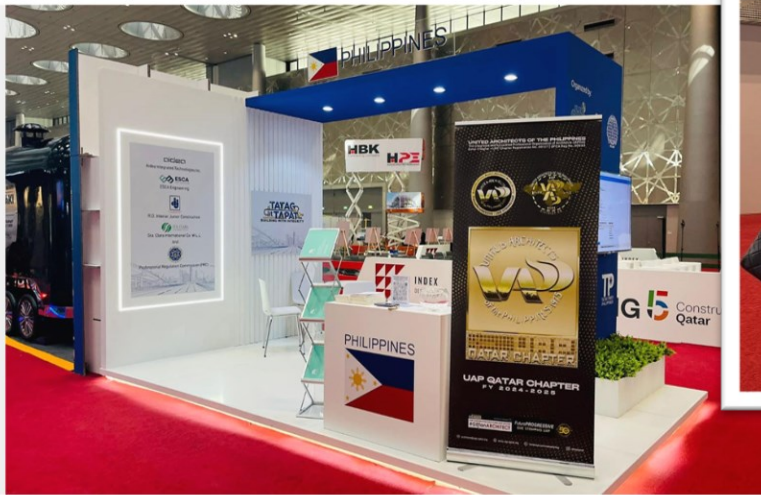
**T**he UAP Qatar chapter is in Big 5 Construct Qatar!
